A. York River Scenic River Designation Request from the Waterman's Museum

Steve Ormsby, President of the Waterman's Museum in Yorktown advised that the first step towards designating the York River as a scenic river location would be for the Town to request that DCR conduct a study of the river.

Mr. Edwards advised that he received a letter of support from Anne Bland, President of the Garden Club of the Middle Peninsula and a phone call of concern from RockTenn that the project could cause issues with any future projects that RockTenn might have.

Mr. Hudson asked if other localities have supported the project.

Mr. Ormsby advised that James City and York County have shown support for the project.

Mr. Hudson asked if King and Queen support the project.

Mr. Ormsby advised no and that New Kent has not acted on the project, they are still reviewing the paperwork.

Mr. Hudson asked if any members of Town Council had any questions or comments.

Mr. Ormsby advised that if the Town approves the study, the Town can stop any further progress at that time.

Mr. Hudson told Mr. Ormsby that the Town would let him know when and if Town Council takes any action.
