COMMITTEE MEETING
August 8th, 2019**

Mr. Lawson called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m. Committee members present included Jack Lawson, Chairman, Deborah Ball, Gail Nichols and James Pruett.

Also present: Robert Lawrence, Town Council Member; John Edwards, Town Manager; Karen Barrow, Town Clerk; Holly McGowan, Director of Community Development; Tim Sawyer, Chief of Police/Building Official; Jon Morr, Building Inspector; Walt Feurer, Director of Public Works and other interested persons.

I Agenda Changes

There were no changes made to the agenda.

II. Adoption of Minutes

July 11th 2019

Gail Nichols made a motion to adopt the minutes as presented, seconded by James Pruett. Upon a unanimous vote, the motion was approved.

III. Presentation on the recent UNESCO Designation

Mr. Edwards advised that Theresa Sirles has sent a packet of information from UNESCO looking for support for an activity that is scheduled for August 25th 2019. The notification is not enough time to take to Town Council. The event is scheduled before the August Town Council meeting, therefore Town Council are unable to take action of support. Mr. Edwards also stated that Ms. Sirles was not available for the meeting today to present the UNESCO information.

The consensus of the Committee is for the Town Manager to invite Ms. Sirles to the September meeting.

IV. Parking on 13th Street

Mr. Edwards advised that currently, Bill Hodges has a trailer and camper parked on 13th Street. When the sale of the house closes, Town Council should consider a No Parking on the South side of 13th Street. There is No Parking on the North side, if there was no parking on the South side it would prevent tractor trailers from parking on 13th Street.

Mr. Edwards also stated that the Town Attorney is currently reviewing the Parking Ordinance. Mr. Edwards asked for the No Parking on 13th Street to be added to the current Public Hearing scheduled on August 27th on the Parking Ordinance.

The consensus of the Committee is for the Town Manager to proceed with a public hearing on the No Parking on 13th Street.

V. General Information

Mr. Lawson asked what the status is of the Pride in your Property program.

Mr. Edwards advised that the interns are now working on Zone 2. Letters are go out for grass cutting and inoperable motor vehicles. Mr. Edward stated that the Interns will be going back to school soon and that the Town will continue work on the project.
