I Call to Order

The Honorable James H. Hudson, III called the meeting to order on April 22nd, 2014 at 6:30 p.m. at Town Hall, 329 6th Street, West Point, Virginia 23181

II PUBLIC HEARINGS

John Edwards, the Town Manager, presented a power point presentation on the Fiscal Year 2014-15 Budget.

A. Fiscal Year 2014-15 Budget

Mr. Hudson read the advertisement then asked the Town Clerk if anyone had obtained a copy of the budget or requested assistance to attend the meeting.

The Town Clerk advised that no requests were received.

Mr. Hudson opened the floor for citizens to comment on the advertisement for the FY 2014-15 Budget.

Mrs. Duddly Olsson, Chairman of the School Board, 4170 Tanager Court, West Point, Virginia thanked Town Council for all their hard work with the budget and for all their work during the past year while working through the tax rate issues with King William County.

Mr. Hudson asked if there was anyone else that wanted to comment on the advertised Budget Public Hearing. There being none, the public hearing was closed.

Mr. Hudson advised that due to State Code, Town Council needs to wait seven days after the public hearing to adopt the budget. The budget will be adopted next Tuesday, April 29th 2014.

B. Ordinance 02-2014 – Tax Rate

Mr. Hudson read the advertisement then asked the Town Clerk if anyone had obtained a copy of Ordinance 02-2014 or asked for assistance to attend the meeting.

The Town Clerk advised no request was received.
