

TOWN OF WEST POINT
Fiscal Year 2017-2018 Budget Public Hearing
MINUTES
April 11th, 2017

I. CALL TO ORDER

The Honorable James H. Hudson, III called the meeting to order at 6:30 P.M. on Tuesday, April 11th 2017 in Town Council chambers, 329 6th Street, West Point, Virginia 23181.

II. BUDGET PRESENTATION

Mr. Edwards reviewed a power point presentation that included the revenues and expenditures of the proposed FY 2017-18 Budget. Mr. Edwards stated that the balanced budget will be \$14,908,683.00 with no increases in Town Taxes. The School budget will increase by \$135,000 with \$75,000 in CIP funding.

III. PUBLIC HEARING – FY 2017-18 Budget

Mayor Hudson stated that the budget was advertised in both the Daily Press and Tidewater Review. Mr. Hudson then read the advertisement and asked the Town Clerk if anyone asked to review the budget.

The Town Clerk advised that no requests were received.

The Town Clerk advised that no requests were received.


Mayor Hudson opened the floor for citizens to comment on the FY 2017-18 Budget.
