Metal Food & Beverage Cans





NO. 1 & 2 PLASTIC BOTTLES

Milk Jugs, Soda Bottles, Household Cleaner Bottles, Shampoo Bottles, and Similar Bottles & Jugs - rinse & remove lids



BAGGED, HOUSEHOLD PAPER: Paper Grocery Bags, Telephone Books, Magazines, Single-Layer Cardboard (cereal and tissue boxes), Junk Mail, Cards, Stationery, School Paper, Computer Paper, flattened boxes; shredded paper in clear bags

BAGGED, Newspaper - clean & dry



Corrugated Cardboard

clean & dry, flattened, no larger than 3x4 ft pieces

Glass Bottles & Jars clear, brown & green - rinse & remove lids



WHAT CAN NOT BE RECYCLED!!

- Wet Paper, Greasy Paper (Pizza boxes), Waxy Paper (Freezer Food Boxes), or Lined Paper (Milk Cartons & Juice Boxes)
- Books, Hardbound or paperback
- Napkins, paper towels, tissues
- Carbon Paper or Wads of paper
- Twine, String or Wire
- Ceramic Dishes, or ovenware
- Plate Glass (Window panes, mirrors)
- Light Bulbs: Fluorescent & Regular)
- Needles or other Medical Waste
- Clothes Hangers, Lawn Chair Frames, Pots & Pans, or Other Scrap Metal
- Paint cans with paint in them
- Any plastic Pesticide, Poison or Automotive product containers
- Plastic Bags - grocery, dry cleaning or garbage, sandwich bags, plastic containers
- Plastic Microwave Dishes, Clear plastic, "Clamshell" (salad or bakery containers), Butter Tubs, Yogurt Cups "Tupperware"
- Plastic Toys, Plastic Plant Pots, Plastic Pipes
- Foam Plastic Products - "Styrofoam" cups, plates, packing materials
- Diapers, Other Personal Care Products
- Food Contaminated or wet cardboard
- Plastic Lined Aluminum Cans

DID YOU KNOW?

- To insure that your recyclables are collected. Place your items out no later than 7AM on collection day.
- That through our recycling efforts during 2018, The Department of Energy says that we saved about:
 - 430,780 gallons of water
 - 1,046 thirty foot pulp trees
 - 250,989 Kilowatt hours of electricity
 - Reduced about 3,692 pounds of air pollutants
 - 23,382 gallons of oil
 - 215 cubic yards of landfill space
