

3 Simple Steps for Town of West Point Refuse Collection

Step 1

SAFETY - To protect our hardworking Public Works crew, trash containers should not be filled to overflowing, and when filled, should not exceed 200 pounds in weight.



Step 2

CURB APPEAL - All containers provided by the Town of West Point for trash collection should be placed on a public street, as near to the curb or street as possible, or except where public alleys are provided, between 1st and 23rd Streets at 7:00 a.m. the day of collection. Containers shall not be placed at the roadside for collection more than 12 hours before the regularly scheduled collection time, and must be removed from the roadside no later than 7:00 p.m. of the day of collection. Bulk refuse* may be placed at the location common for container placements in a manner not to interfere with regular trash collection.

Step 3

EFFICIENCY - No bags, bundles of solid waste or yard waste may be placed outside of a trash container for collection, nor may any private containers be set out for collection by Town of West Point Public Works.
