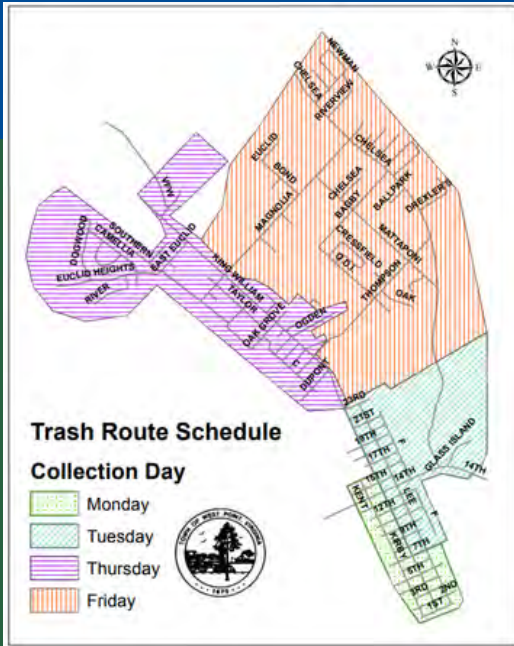


Refuse & Recycling Information

The Town of West Point's Public Works Department provides solid waste collection services to Town of West Point residents and select businesses. Services include weekly refuse and recycling collection, monthly bulk refuse collection, and assistance with removal of yard waste.

Regular Refuse Collection

- All containers provided by the Town of West Point for trash collection should be placed on a public street, as near to the curb or street as possible, or except where public alleys are provided, between 1st and 23rd Streets by 7am the day of collection (refer to the Trash Route Schedule below for your collection day). Containers shall not be placed at the roadside for collection more than 12 hours before the regularly scheduled collection time, and must be removed from the roadside no later than 7pm of the day of collection.
- Trash containers should not be filled to overflowing, and when filled, should not exceed 200 pounds in weight.
- No bags, bundles of solid waste or yard waste may be placed outside of a trash container for collection, nor may any private containers be set out for collection by Town of West Point Public Works.



Bulk Refuse Collection

- Bulk Refuse Collection is the second Thursday of each month.
- A Work Order must be submitted for Bulk Refuse Collection. Please contact Town Hall at 804-843-3330 or wpreception@west-point.va.us to submit your request.
- Place your bulk refuse out for collection by 7am.
- Bulk Refuse Collection is available from residential properties but is not available from short-term rentals or businesses.
- Bulk refuse includes oversized household trash and bulky items such as furniture or appliances. (Remove doors from furniture and appliances.)
- Bulk Refuse Collection is not available for industrial and commercial waste, construction debris, or hazardous/medical waste.

Transfer Station

The VFW Road transfer station accepts both household trash and recyclables.

Refuse & Recycling Information

Recycling Collection

- Recyclables are collected weekly on Wednesdays.
- Place your recyclables out for collection no later than 7am on Wednesday.
- Acceptable recyclables include:
 - Bagged Household Paper
 - Paper grocery bags, single layer cardboard (cereal and tissues boxes), junk mail, cards, stationary, and paper
 - Aluminum Foil Products
 - Rinsed and emptied metal food and beverage cans
 - No.  and No.  Plastic Bottles
 - Rinsed and emptied milk jugs, soda bottles, household cleaner bottles and jugs
 - Bagged Newspaper
 - Clean and dry newspaper
 - Corrugated Cardboard
 - Clean, dry and flattened; maximum size of 3x4 feet, NO PIZZA BOXES
 - Glass Bottles and Jars
 - Rinsed and emptied clear, brown, and green jars

Yard Debris Collection

- Public Works will collect residential yard waste such as branches, limbs, bushes, shrubbery cuttings, leaves, and lawn clippings.
- This service is available for homeowner generated debris only.
- A Work Order must be submitted for Yard Debris Collection. Please contact Town Hall at 804-843-3330 or wpreception@west-point.va.us to submit your request.
- Place your yard debris out for collection no later than 7am.
- Yard waste should be placed in a neat and organized pile in your normal collection location (not in your trash container).
- Limbs, shrubbery cuttings, etc. should be a maximum of 4 feet in length and 4 inches wide.
- Leaves, small clippings, etc. should be bagged.

- What items are not recyclable? Wet, greasy, waxy, or lined paper (pizza boxes, milk/juice cartons); magazines; string or twine; hardback and paperback books; ceramics; plate glass; carbon paper; needles and other medical waste; clothes hangers; lawn chair frames; light bulbs; paint cans with paint inside; pots and pans; pesticide/poison containers; plastic bags; plastic plates and utensils; butter and yogurt tubs; plastic toys; Styrofoam products; diapers; plastic-lined aluminum
